MARACANDA

An exotic collection of printed and embroidered fabrics takes inspiration from the textiles of the ancient Silk Route. The designs evoke the rich and varied cultures and crafts to be found in the cities along the length of the Great Silk Road, Maracanda is the ancient name for Samarkand, the jewel of Uzbekistan and the most famous of the Silk Road cities.



ANATOLIA

A decorative pattern with a large central medallion is inspired by Persian carpets. The design is screen-printed by hand on a linen with a subtle slub to emulate the unique characteristics of a hand-crafted antique rug.





TOPKAPI

Large medallions inspired by Iznik ceramics are presented within an ogee trellis of climbing foliage. Printed on a hopsack weave.



PARSA
A luxurious velvet with
a subtle fan-shaped pattern.

A tree of life design, inspired by the textiles of South East India, is realised in a soft painterly manner and printed on a herringbone linen, providing a modern take ona traditional chintz.





TURFAN

A collection of versatile weaves including sumptuous velvets, chenilles and small-scale patterned fabrics. The colours from Nina's characteristic palette include aqua, green, gold, teal, coral and red, as well as useful neutral shades.
